Letter From our President

Yes! 2022 was an exciting year with Covid-19 restrictions loosening, organizations starting to call back their volunteers for their programs, and live events once again being celebrated in Langley.

A brief look back at 2022...

Thank you to John Tomlinson and the Fairhaven Group as we wrapped up our 2021-2022 Langley Charitable Nights that raised over \$1,700 for each of the 10 Langley non-profit and charitable organizations who participated in these events. We enjoyed great food and music performed by many very talented musicians.

In addition to our amazing Langley Volunteer Bureau Program Achievements listed in our 2022 Annual Report, our BetterOrg Volunteer Management and Scheduling program assisted two of Langley's 2022 largest events. The Fort Langley Jazz and Arts Festival in July utilized our BetterOrg Volunteer Management and Scheduling program – 155 volunteers filled 73 volunteer positions for a total of 914 volunteer hours. The Langley Volunteer Bureau managed and scheduled volunteers for the Rotary Club's of Langley Ribfest in August using our BetterOrg Volunteer Management and Scheduling program – 235 volunteers filled 588 volunteer positions for a total of 3,670 volunteer hours.

For 2023 we look forward to continuing our Cards for Seniors program – connecting students with seniors while continuing to reach over 10,000 students and seniors annually.

We are grateful for funding from the New Horizon Seniors Programs and the City of Langley for our new 'Snow Angels' program. Planning has begun and the launch of the Snow Angel program is September 2023 and will include the City of Langley and the Township of Langley. The Snow Angel program assists seniors and people with mobility challenges to clear their sidewalks, which is a municipal bylaw requirement. Volunteers are recruited and provided locations requiring snow clearing and salting for seniors and/or people with mobility challenges who have registered for this service.

We are looking forward to celebrating National Volunteer Week, April 16th to 22nd by promoting volunteerism in our community and supporting our members as they celebrate their volunteers. We are hosting our first Volunteer Fair in 3 years on April 22nd and look forward to volunteers, non-profit, and charitable organizations making great connections benefitting everyone.

Our partnership with the School District of Langley continues to grow as we continue to engage students in a variety of volunteer opportunities and programs and are thankful for the support we receive from the School Board and the teachers.

Due to the growth in registered volunteers, the success of the Cards for Seniors program, our new Snow Angels program, and maintaining and supporting our members, the Board of Directors of the Langley Volunteer Bureau will be reaching out to the community for people to join us to ensure the sustainability and attainment of our mission and goals

Members

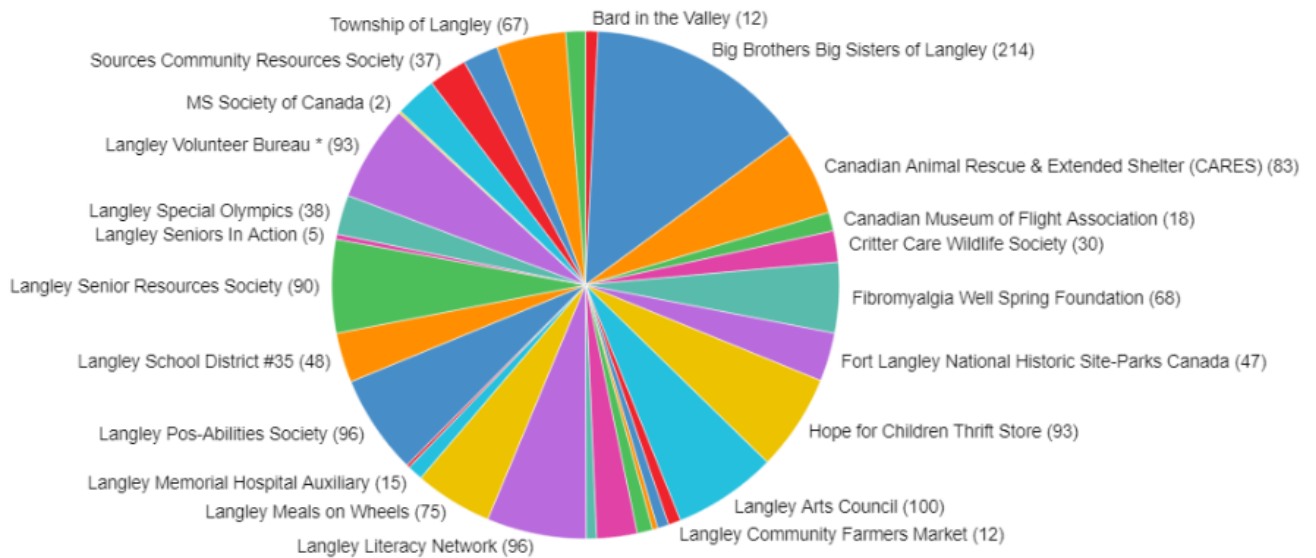
- Referred over 600 new volunteers to our members! Almost double over last year!

Cards for Seniors

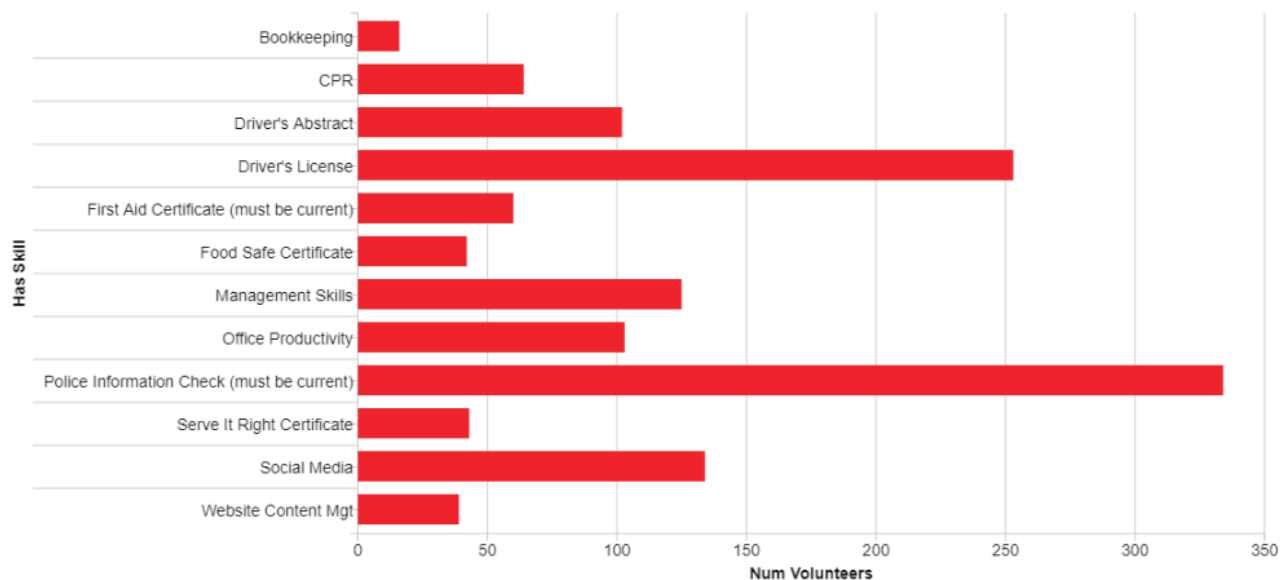
- Delivered over 10,000 cards to seniors in Langley! Thank you to the Langley School District Printshop!

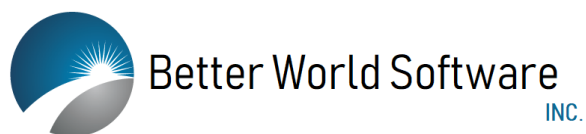

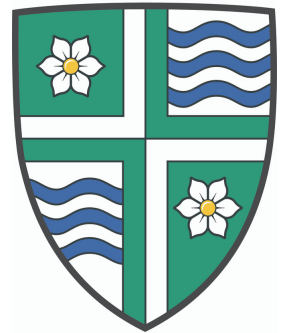
